*Devistan I.* The Nainital Mountaineering Club sent a nine-member team led by Anup Sah to prepare for a scientific cum exploratory expedition to the Nanda Devi Sanctuary next summer. On October 3 Nayan Kumar Katira and two high-altitude porters Tej Singh and Karam Bahadur climbed Devistan I (21,910 feet).

*Trisul and P 21,220.* Trisul (23,360 feet) was climbed by Sadananda Das, Aninda Sen, Jeten Mitra, Dawle M. Kindo, Nima Dorje and Sher Singh on September 21. Prabir K. Banerjee, Kalsadhan Banerjee, Sovon Gupta, Dwijen Roy, Nima Dorje and Kitare climbed P 21,220 on September 23. They named this Bahuguna Parbat. It is northeast of Trisul.

*Hanuman.* This ladies' expedition climbed Hanuman (19,930 feet) above the Rishi gorge. Camp I was established on June 21 at the foot of Rishikot at 17,000 feet. Camp II was set up the next day at 18,000 feet. Although the weather turned bad on June 23, on the 24th Miss Usha Bhide and Miss Nazneen Katrak and Sherpas Tashi and Karma dashed out of Camp II at 6:40. They were caught in a blizzard and yet reached the summit at 11:45.

*Gangotri I and III and Rudugaira.* Of a ten-member expedition of the Corps of Electrical and Mechanical Engineers, Majors J.K. Bajaj, I. S. Kumar and S.L. Deora, Captains P.P. Rao and K.B. Sood, Havildar Kuldip Singh, Havildar Sherpa Natembu and Sherpa Balwent Singh climbed Gangotri III (21,578 feet) on May 30. On July 5, while Camp I was being set up at 18,000 feet Deora, Sood and Lubdwere climbed Rudugaira (18,790 feet). On June 8, Deora, Natembu, Rao and Thondup climbed Gangotri I (21,890 feet).

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*Deoban attempts and P 21,122.* An Indian Air Force team set up an advance camp on Deoban (22,480 feet) and made summit bids on June 17 and 19 but was foiled by inclement weather. They diverted to P 21,122 which Nawang Phenzo and two other members climbed on June 22.
