

Halancoma and Huacratanca Ascents

Halancoma North (5,300m)

1. Piero Gighlione, 1953
 2. Scots from north, normal route, 1964
 3. Polish, south peak to north peak traverse, 1975
 4. Tom Hendrickson (USA) and John Saunders (CAN), normal route, 1981
- There have been many ascents by local groups via the normal route (north face, F/PD).*

Halancoma South (5,367m)

1. Piero Gighlione, 1953
2. Tom Hendrickson (USA) and John Saunders (CAN), east face/buttreass, 1981
3. Cesar Cahuana and Alfredo Zuniga (Peru) traversed from the north peak to the south along, or just on the east side, of the ridge between the two peaks, 2015
4. Brad Johnson and Andres Marin, west face (not to summit), 2016
5. Coqui Galvez (Peru) climbed a route solo on the south face in December 2016 at about PD 55–65° snow/ice

Huacratanca (5,000m)

1. Piero Gighlione, 1953
2. Polish, south to north, 1975
3. Carlos Buhler, west to east, 1987
4. There have been many ascents of this peak by the southwest glacial tongue, which is disappearing. *Sometime around 2010, the summit ice melted and the summit is now a 25-meter rocky point that goes at easy 5th class. I believe that local climbers, Alfredo Zuniga and Jorge Sirvas climbed the rock point first in 2014.*
