
Shivling, East Pillar, Second Ascent. Americans Mark Richey and John Bouchard made a rapid second ascent of this often-tried route in June. A full account of their climb appears earlier in this journal.

Shivling, West Ridge, Various Ascents. It was reported that two teams were successful on Shivling's west ridge: a four-man German team led by Walter Haderadorfer, on August 22 and 23, in two different groups; and a nine-member Korean team led by Min Ho-Park. (High Mountain Sports 174)

Bhagirathi III, Southwest Pillar, Attempts. It was reported that three teams attempted the southwest pillar of Bhagirathi III (6454 m): a four-man Spanish expedition led by Juan Padilla, a six-member Canadian team led by Graham Rowbotham, and another team from Spain. None were successful. (High Mountain Sports 174)

Bhagirathi IV, Attempt. It was reported that a six-member Spanish team failed the unclimbed, west-facing rock wall rising to Pt. 6173m on the ridge connecting Bhagirathi II and III. (High Mountain Sports 174)

Satopanth, Northeast Ridge. The expedition consisted of 12 members with two high altitude porters. We established Base Camp in Vasuki Tal at 4900 meters on July 3, 1995, Camp I on
